QUESTION REQUESTING CLARIFICATION

The following questions were received:

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| 1 | Question: | Is the intent of the asphalt grinding items to completely remove the asphalt on driveways and cul-de-sac? If so, can we remove the existing asphalt by peeling instead of grinding? |
| | Reply: | The intent is to remove the asphalt for the driveways up to the property line. At the property line, the existing asphalt will have to be matched with a ground overlap and sawcut. Because we are overlaying 98% of the cul de sac, the contractor could peel away all the asphalt at the entrances. However, if they do this, they will have to provide padding to compensate for the removal of the extra material where they tie-in with the existing asphalt. If they are willing to do this without requesting an extra, rather than grind it, this will be acceptable |
