The following questions were received:

1	Question:	<p>Line item; 1.1 Invitation to Proponents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o "This Request for Proposals ("RFP") is an invitation to prospective Proponents to submit Proposals for the provision of a New Radio/Paging System ("Goods") to support the City of Clarence-Rockland Fire department....." <input type="checkbox"/> As per statement in line item 1.3 Objectives, Does the municipality want to keep some of the radio technologies? If so, can the municipality provide a "list of good" to keep? <input checked="" type="checkbox"/>
	Reply:	<p>The Municipality has a backup paging system currently, that the City would intend to keep (depending on whether the Municipality switches paging systems). This is not otherwise covered in this RFP and should be left out. All other radio equipment, to the best of the City's knowledge, is outdated and needs to be replaced. Should a vendor wish to re-use any of the existing equipment, or provide a trade-in credit for existing equipment (incl. portables, etc.) this should be identified in their bid.</p>
2	Question:	<p>Line item; 2.2 Scope of work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o "The system should be designed with multiple 'tac' channels to permit simultaneous operation on different talk groups." <input type="checkbox"/> How many of TAC channels does the the municipality desire? o "7 base-station radios w/ desk mic & remote head capabilities to allow for a separate transmission location w/ antenna & cables." <input type="checkbox"/> Can the municipality specify if "remote base" requires a "mirror display" from the actual base station?
	Reply:	<p>The Fire Department requires one (1) primary dispatch channel, and three (3) TAC channels. Ideally, if remaining in the VHF bandwidth, the City would also require the ability to program in other VHF frequencies (i.e. OFM, Hawkesbury Dispatch, etc.).</p> <p>The seven (7) base station radios shall be installed in the following locations: Station 1 (Bourget) Watch Room, Station 2 (Clarence) Watch Room, Station 3 (Rockland) Watch Room, Station 3 (Rockland) Chiefs Office, Station 3 (Rockland) Deputy's Office, Station 3 (Rockland) Emergency Operations Centre (Classroom), and the last will be setup for a page-to-email function (location TBD). The three base stations being installed in the watch rooms, should have a remote head (incl. mic) that can be installed on the apparatus bay floor, such that the radio can be heard and transmitted from at either location (e.g. watch room or apparatus bay floor).</p>
3	Question:	<p>Can the municipality provide us with specific antennas types? (1/4 wave or hi gain)</p>
	Reply:	<p>Please provide recommendations and explanations for each. The recommendation should be included in the bid, with the alternate listed as an option with a price (or savings).</p>
4	Question:	<p>Can the municipality tell us who is responsible for the Ottawa fire console programming? (DMR selective calling)</p>
	Reply:	<p>The City of Ottawa maintains proprietary rights to their console. Any and all programming must be done through Ottawa Fire. There will be additional costs, which the City shall assume for programming the consoles. The City will assist the successful bidder in making these contacts, and will provide further contact information to the successful proponent.</p>
